Pursuant to your request to Mr. Kevin Nursick of our Communications office for plans and correspondence relative to the subject project, please find attached an electronic copy of the latest progress drawings we have from the City's Consulting Engineer for the East Ave. roadway reconstruction project (dated Jan 2013), as well as correspondence confirming the City's support for the property acquisitions/construction of commuter parking area at the northwest quadrant of the railroad overpass.
